Crunch Time for Education Funding

For two years, POWER has campaigned to get our schools fully and fairly funded so our children can get the quality education they deserve. All of our work for a Full, Fair Funding Formula (FFFF) comes to a head on June 30, the due date for Pennsylvania's 2015-16 budget, and POWER will hold a ten-day fast from June 20-30 to support the FFFF.
